Purpose

The Board acknowledges the usefulness of a system of computing grade point averages and class ranking for secondary school graduates to inform students, parents/guardians, and others of their relative academic placement among their peers under relatively similar circumstances.

Authority

The Board authorizes a system of class ranking, for students in grades 9 through 12 in which all students shall be ranked together.

A student's grade point average and rank in class shall be entered on his/her record and shall be subject to the Board's policy on release of student records.[1]

Guidelines

The method of calculation and reporting class rank shall be defined in the Educational Planning Guide.

Delegation of Responsibility

The Superintendent shall develop procedures for the computation of grade point averages and the assignment of rank in class to implement this policy.
