Purpose

Section

The Board recognizes that compulsory attendance laws impose on the Board the custodianship of the public school children of the district while they are present in the schools.[1]

Guidelines

Police interviews with students shall be conducted in the presence of the building principal. Parents or legal guardians of the pupil to be interviewed shall be notified as soon as possible.

In the event it becomes necessary to make an apprehension during school hours, the child shall be summoned to the principal's office before being released from school into the custody of the police. Whenever possible, the parents or legal guardians of the child shall be notified before the child is released in the custody of the police.
